

## Student Health & Wellness for Success Center Volunteer Guidelines for Mobile Markets

Thank you for agreeing to serve as a volunteer at the Mobile Market. The Mobile Market Program is only one portion of our *Fuel For Success: Nourishing the Mind, Body and Spirit* initiative. It also includes supporting the campus food pantries and identifying community resources that address food insecurities.

Below are guidelines that all volunteers must adhere to by serving with the Mobile Market Program.

1. Volunteers should commit a minimum of one hour. However, volunteers are encouraged to serve for the entire market.

- Volunteer duties include helping set up the market by unloading food from pallets to tables, restocking food on tables, distributing food, cleaning area, breaking down boxes, greeting customers (student, faculty, staff & community members), assisting with registering customers.
- 3. Volunteers should not throw away food that appears to be damaged. The Capital Area Food Bank does not promote waste of food. Rather, all matters should be directed to the MC Mobile Market Coordinators, Carmen Poston Travis or Benita Rashaw, and we will decide what and how to discard.
- 4. Volunteers will be permitted to make market selections during a time deemed appropriate by the Coordinators. A space will be allotted for storage of market selections but cannot be near the food service tables. Faculty/staff will be permitted to make market selections <u>after</u> the market has closed or at appropriate time.
- 5. Please be aware the market is open to the community in general. So, no one is excluded.
